Term Four 2024

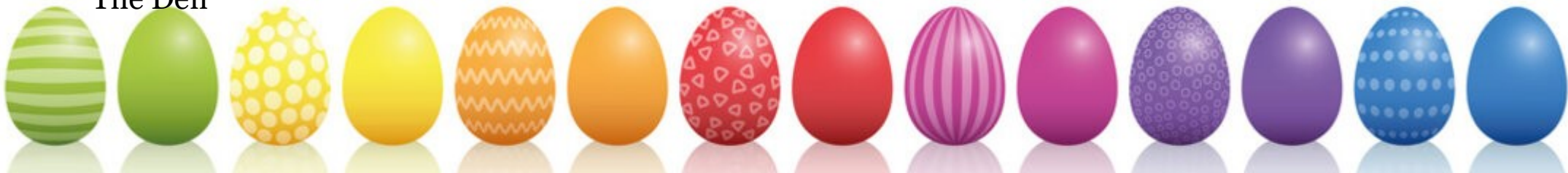
We hope this finds you happily in full swing of the Easter break and that you are being afforded some rest.

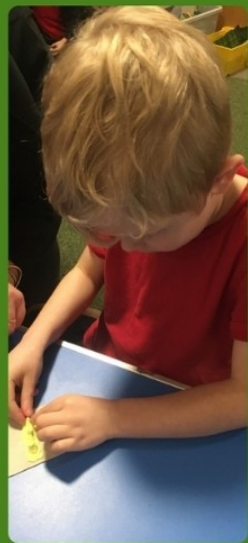
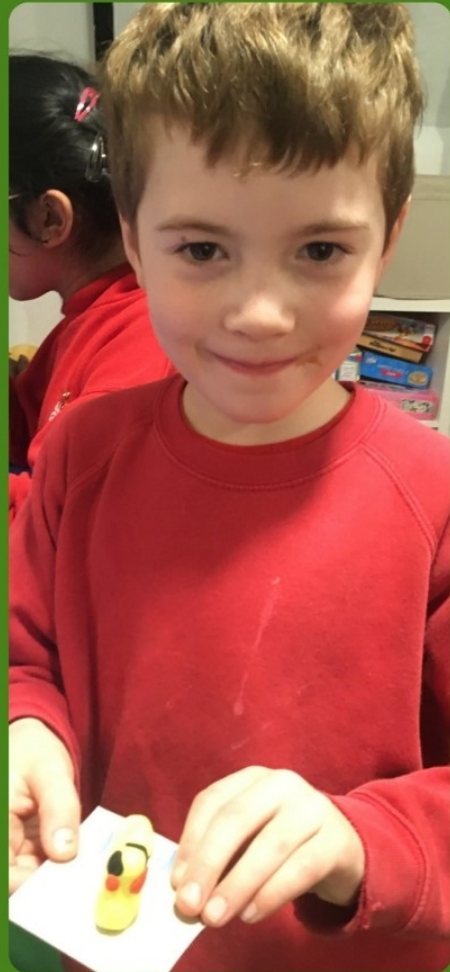
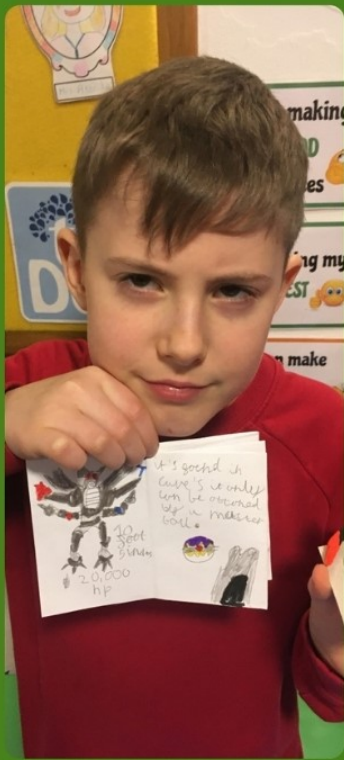


Pokémon Week

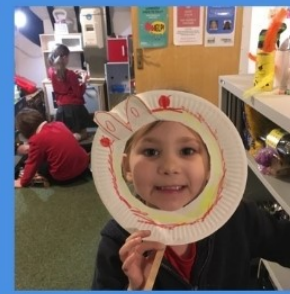


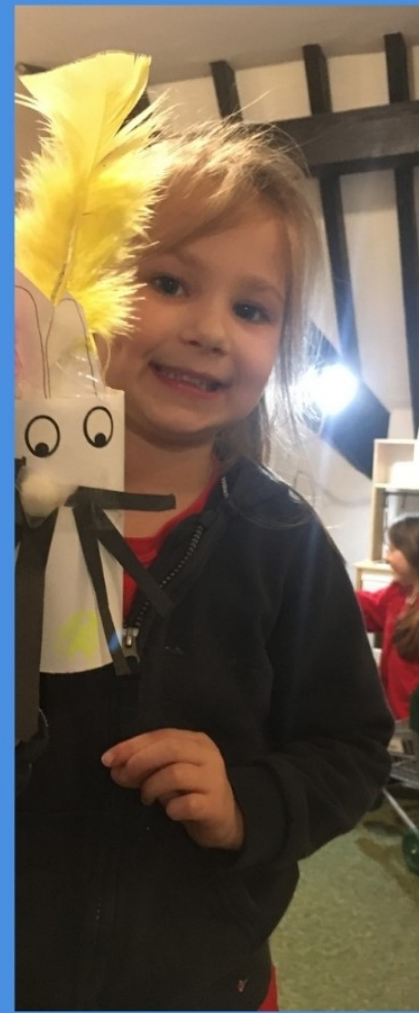
Happy Easter
